1. Apologies and announcements

2. Meeting Minutes for 145th Meeting

ACNFP/145/MINS

2.1 The Committee had agreed the minutes via correspondence of the 145th meeting of the ACNFP held on 27th January 2021 and these were published on the ACNFP's website on 17th March 2021.

3. Matters Arising from the last meeting.

ACNFP/146/MA

- 3.1 The Committee reviewed a CBD application received under the novel food's authorisation processes. The Secretariat thank the Committee for their comments which will be collated, and a summary produced. This will first be signed off by the Committee and then sent back to the applicant.
- 3.2 The Committee were provided with an update on ongoing work between the FSA, UKAS and LGC. The FSA will be meeting with its partners to discuss this work further in a couple of weeks.
- 3.3 Members were invited to consider and provide feedback on the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (Defra) consultation on the regulation of genetic technologies. A GM working group was formed and their response was an Agenda item for this meeting.

4. DEFRA consultation on the Regulation of Genetic Technologies

ACNFP/146/01

- 4.1 Between the 145th and 146th ACNFP meeting the ACNFP members formed a 5-member GE technologies working group which produced a draft response to the consultation.
- 4.2 Members were asked to consider the draft response to the DEFRA genetic technologies consultation provided by the working group and to provide feedback.

The Comments

- 4.3 The Committee expect GE products to be regulated. This could, in some cases, be outside the existing GMO regulation if it could be demonstrated that the product produced through genome editing could have been produced through traditional breeding.
- 4.4 The Committee advised that GE products (even if outside of GMO regulation) must continue to be assessed for consumer safety on a case-by-case basis.
- 4.5 The Committee discussed the fact that the current novel foods regulation includes a risk assessment process that could potentially be modified to create an appropriate risk assessment structure for genome edited products. However, specific new guidance would need to be developed.
- 4.6 The Committee considered that, as a new and transformative technology, GE and its outputs will need to be considered carefully for safety.
- 4.7 The final ACNFP response to the DEFRA consultation will be made publicly available.

Action: These comments will be collated and used by the FSA Secretariat to edit and re-write the consultation letter in line with the Committee's comments.
