OPINION ON THE SUBSTANTIAL EQUIVALENCE OF PHYTOSTEROL ESTERS

The Food Standards Agency, the UK competent authority for all novel food issues has completed your request for an opinion on the substantial equivalence of your phytosterol ester ingredient. The basis of your request for an opinion is that you have been a major supplier of phytosterol esters to Unilever, who have used them in their Flora (Becel) *pro.Activ* yellow fat spread product since 2000, and in milk and yoghurt type products since March 2004.

We have reviewed the information you have supplied in support of this request and I am pleased to inform you that we accept that your phytosterol esters meet the criteria for equivalence, as defined in Article 3(4) of regulation (EC) 258/97.

This opinion is issued on the basis that your phytosterol ester ingredient is to be used in the following food products in accordance with the conditions specified in the named Commission Decisions:

- Milk type products and yoghurt type products, as described in Commission Decision 2004/335/EC.
- Yellow Fat Spreads, as described in Commission Decision 2000/500/EC.

We also advise that you inform all customers that food products containing plant sterols and sterol esters should be labelled in accordance with Regulation (EC) 608/2004.

Please note that, in accordance with Article 5 of (EC) 258/97, you should notify the European Commission when you intend to market your phytosterol ester ingredients when they are first marketed.
